3. Legal basis

Collection of data for the purpose of application and participation in a CIVIS Summer school:

Art. 6 para. 1 lit. e) i.V.m. Para. 3 EU Data Protection Regulation (DSGVO) in conjunction with. § Section 12 (1) of the State Higher Education Act (LHG) of January 1, 2005, last amended by Article 1 of the Act of March 13, 2018 (GBl. p. 85) in conjunction with the Ordinance of the Ministry of Science on the Collection and Processing of Personal Data of Applicants, Students and Examination Candidates for Administrative Purposes of Higher Education Institutions (Higher Education Data Protection Ordinance) of August 28, 1992 (GBl. p. 667).

4. Purpose and scope of data processing

6. Duration of storage

Your submitted application documents will be kept for 5 years and then destroyed. After this period, personal data will be deleted in accordance with the legal requirements.

7. Your rights

- You have the right to obtain information from the Faculty of Medicine about the personal data stored about you in accordance with Art. 15 DSGVO and/or to have inaccurately stored personal data corrected in accordance with Art. 16 DSGVO.
- You also have the right to erasure in accordance with Art. 17 DSGVO, to restriction of processing (Art. 18 DSGVO) and a right to object to processing (Art. 21 DSGVO).
- In case of consent, you can revoke it at any time and without disadvantages. The lawfulness of the data processing until the revocation remains unaffected by this.
